Overview


- The 144 bed Willow Square Continuing Care Centre is scheduled to start construction in early spring (2018).
- When completed, Fort McMurray will have a modern continuing care centre at Willow Square, that will meet their needs now and well into the future.
- In addition to the Continuing Care Centre, the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo and local stakeholders are developing an aging-in-place component on the Willow Square site.
- It is expected that construction will be completed in the fall of 2019.

Status updates

- The evaluation of the proposals from the Request for Tender for the Design Build of the Continuing care centre has almost been completed.
- An announcement on the successful proposal is expected in early 2018.

Key project milestones

- Geotechnical testing and site investigations completed spring 2017
- Bridging/Master plan consultant completed summer/fall 2017
- Finalization of functional and schematic design completed summer 2017
- Request for Proposal for a Design Build Contractor late fall 2017
- Design-Build contract awarded early 2018
- Construction starting spring 2018
- Construction completed fall 2019
- Anticipated opening spring 2020.
