Project Update Calgary Cancer Centre (CCC)

Overview

- This is a priority project for the Alberta Government that will deliver a first-class health care facility and academic centre for the provision of cancer services in southern Alberta.
- The Capital Plan 2018 allocated \$1.4 billion over next five years to increase cancer care capacity in Calgary and southern Alberta by consolidating and expanding upon existing services that will deliver integrated and comprehensive cancer care.
- The Calgary Cancer Centre is being constructed at the Foothills Medical Centre to allow cancer care to be integrated with current key programs and services.
- Construction has started and is scheduled to be complete in 2022, with the new facility opening to the public in 2023.
- The new Calgary Cancer Centre is part of a comprehensive infrastructure strategy for cancer treatment in Calgary that includes both inpatient and outpatient services that include:
 - o Outpatient cancer clinics
 - o Inpatient unit beds
 - o Operational and clinical support services
 - o Clinical trials unit and research laboratories
 - Systemic and radiation treatment services
 - New on-site parking

Design/Construction update

- The project site was turned over to the contractor in October 2017, with utility work, shoring, piling and excavation underway.
- Construction on the Bone Marrow Transplant Unit interim renovation is underway and anticipated to be completed by May 2019
