

Project Update

Lethbridge Chinook Regional Hospital



Overview

- The renovation and expansion for the Lethbridge Chinook Regional Hospital was undertaken in three phases:
 - Renovation to Day Procedures area, including expansion to vacated cancer clinic (completed July 2013);
 - New wing expansion including a five-storey addition of approximately 19,000 square metres (completed October 2015); and
 - Renovations to the emergency department (completed September 2016) and cancer clinic (completed February 2018).
- The Chinook Regional Hospital redevelopment provided improved access to outpatient services, specialized care and emergency services.
- The top two levels of the new addition includes roughed-in space for future development/expansion.
- Approximately 3,500 square metres of space is being renovated in other parts of the existing health centre.

Construction Update

Renovated Impacted Departments and Cancer Clinic

- Rehabilitation department was turned over to Alberta Health Services in September 2016.
- Labour & Delivery department was turned over to Alberta Health Services in November 2016.
- Phase 1 - Pharmacy at the cancer centre was completed and turned over to Alberta Health Services in February 2017.
- Phase 2 - at the Jack Ady Cancer Centre was completed and turned over to Alberta Health Services in July 2017.
- Phase 3 - Jack Ady Cancer Centre was completed and turned over to Alberta Health Services in February 2018.
