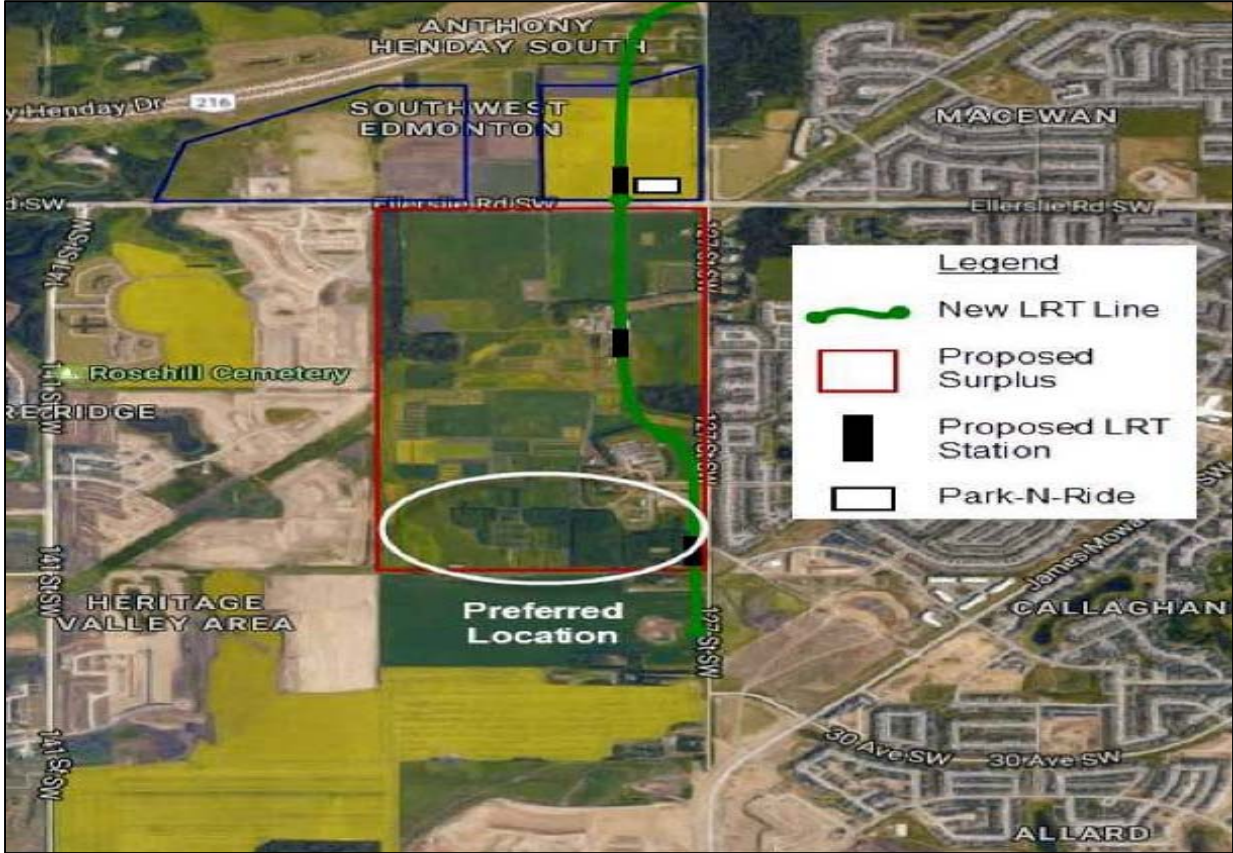


Project Update

New Edmonton Hospital



Overview

- The Province has allocated capital funding to begin planning and development of a new community hospital in Edmonton.
- The new hospital will be located in south-west Edmonton, near 127 Street.
- It is expected to take approximately a decade to complete planning, design, and construction of the new hospital.
- It is anticipated that the new hospital will include a comprehensive mix of acute services that are based on identified community needs. These services could include:
 - Inpatient beds;
 - Emergency department;
 - Rehabilitation services;
 - Obstetrical services;
 - Diagnostic treatment;
 - Ambulatory services.

Upcoming Activities

- Project planning is currently underway, including development of the site master plan.
- The Province and the City of Edmonton are developing the Neighbourhood Area Structure Plan (NASP) that will include the site selected for the project.
- Land use planning and engineering studies to support the planned site development are underway, in conjunction with the development of the NASP.
- Design and construction milestones for various components of project scope will be confirmed during the planning phase.

Next steps

- Complete the clinical service and undertake functional programming of component spaces.
- Establish site planning and procurement options that can meet requirements.
- Stakeholder engagement activity in support of the project planning phase.

Project Milestones

- Project Initiation: 2017
- Planning and Procurement: 2018 - 2020
- Preliminary Site Works: 2020
- Design: 2021 - 2022
- Construction and Commissioning: 2021 - 2026
- Public Opening (expected): 2027
