

Project Update

Peter Lougheed Centre, Calgary

(Vascular Surgery and Women's Health Renovations)



Overview

- The 2017-2021 Capital Plan allocates \$19 million over the next two years to complete renovations at the Peter Lougheed Centre (Vascular Surgery and Women's Health renovations).
- These projects will deliver a patient-centred care model to improve access and quality of care to meet current Alberta Health Services care standards.
- The project will also facilitate the transfer of and improvements to services provided by the impacted pediatrics and hemodialysis departments.
- The redevelopment encompasses the consolidation, renovation and expansion of services to the existing Vascular Surgery and Women's Health programs.

Redeveloped Acute Care Services

- Vascular Surgery: Ambulatory care
- Vascular Surgery: Inpatient/ step down unit
- Vascular Surgery: Surgical suite
- Women's Health: Triage / Labour and Delivery
- Women's Health: Antepartum
- Women's Health: Postpartum
- Women's Health: Neonatal intensive care
- Impacted Department: Hemodialysis
- Impacted Department: Pediatrics

Construction Update

- The redevelopment consists of three phases:
 - Phase 1 - Redevelopment of impacted departments **(completed April 2014)**;
 - Phase 2 - Vascular Surgery and Hybrid Operating Rooms **(completed September 2015)**; and
 - Phase 3 - The Women's Health Unit on level 3 is currently under construction.
 - The Neonatal Intensive Care Unit was completed and turned over to Alberta Health Services in February 24, 2017 and is operational.
 - New Labour and Delivery Unit – Have commenced headwall and fixture installation. Mechanical and electrical rough-ins at the new triage spaces are in progress.
 - Public and service elevator lobbies work is nearing completion.

Next Steps and Upcoming Activities

- Construction activity continues on the Phase 3 Women's Health Unit. Construction is expected to be completed and turned over to Alberta Health Services in late 2017.
- Complete mechanical and electrical work.
- Continue construction in the Labour and Delivery Unit.
