Project Update Edson Healthcare Centre/Community Health and Wellness Clinic



Overview

- In this year's Capital Plan, \$14 million was allocated primarily for the completion of the Community Health and Wellness Clinic, which is expected to be finalized in 2018.
- The recently completed Edson Healthcare Centre includes a variety of health services including acute care, continuing care, primary health care and community health programs.
- The new health facility provides improved access to emergency services, outpatient care and renal dialysis.
- Shared space and co-location of various health professionals in the health centre will support a robust primary care model and bring a "whole care team" to individuals and families in one location.
- The clinical and continuing care facilities are under the one year construction warranty period and have been in operation since November, 2016.

Community Health and Wellness Clinic (CHWC)

- The construction has started and is scheduled to be completed in early 2018.
- Structural steel was erected.
- The framing work (steel studs) is nearing completion.
- Roofing work is nearing completion.
- Electrical and mechanical rough-in work is in progress.
- The conduit installation for exterior lighting is in progress.

Acute Care Building

- The Acute Care building was opened to the public in November 2016.
- Seasonal landscaping work has been completed.

Residential Facility-Based Care Building (Continuing Care Centre)

- The residential facility-based care building (Continuing Care Centre) was opened to the public in November 2016.
- Seasonal landscaping work was completed

Next Steps and Upcoming Activities (Community Health and Wellness Clinic)

- Construction will continue on CHWC.
 - o Complete the framing and rough-in works.
 - o Commence the exterior work (envelope).
