

Project Update

Northern Lights Regional Health Centre (Fort McMurray)



Overview

- The Northern Lights Regional Health Centre project includes the replacement of the exterior cladding, windows and doors, and roofing.
- The project is required to repair issues with the building envelope such as insulation and sealing of the building.
- These actions will extend the life of the facility.

Status

- A portion of the Willow Square site is being used as a temporary holding area and contractor parking for the Northern Lights Hospital-Building Envelope project. Use of this area will not impact any other area projects.
- Demolition for Phase 1 is 95% complete.
- Phase 1 construction of the new wall assembly is underway.
- Window, new exterior wall framing, boarding insulation and air/vapour barrier installations for Phase 1 are in progress.

Next Steps and Upcoming Activities

- Phase 1 construction activity will continue with the installation of roofing and phenolic panel (highly durable wall panelling).
- Construction of the Northern Lights Regional Health Centre - Building Envelope upgrade is scheduled to be completed in early 2020.
