Project Update

Fort McMurray Continuing Care Centre (Willow Square)



Overview

- The 144 bed Willow Square Continuing Care Centre is scheduled to start construction in early spring (2018).
- In response to a Request for Proposal (RFP), three proponent groups are developing proposals for the design, construction schedule, and project budget.
- The evaluation committee will evaluate the three proposals and award the contract to the successful proponent.
- It is expected that construction will be completed in early 2020.
- When completed, Fort McMurray will have a modern continuing care centre at Willow Square, that will meet their needs now and well into the future.
- In addition to the Continuing Care Centre, the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo and local stakeholders are developing an aging-in-place component on the Willow Square site.

Status

- Key project milestones include:
 - Geotechnical testing and site investigations completed spring 2017
 - Bridging /Master plan consultant-completed summer/fall 2017
 - Finalization of functional and schematic design –summer 2017
 - Request for Proposal for a design Build Contractor underway, fall 2017
 - Design-Build contract awarded fall 2017
 - Construction starting- spring 2018
 - Project completed early 2020.
