Project Update Calgary Cancer Centre (CCC)



Construction is expected to get underway in late 2017 and the facility will open to the public in 2023.

Overview

- In this year's Capital Plan, the province has allocated over \$1.19 billion dollars over the next four years for the development of the Calgary Cancer Centre (CCC).
- This CCC is a priority project for the Alberta Government that will deliver a first-class health care facility and academic centre for the provision of cancer services in southern Alberta.
- The new cancer centre will increase cancer care capacity in Calgary by consolidating and expanding upon existing services in the Calgary zone to deliver integrated and comprehensive cancer care.
- As mandated by the Provincial Cancer Strategy and the Calgary Cancer Service Plan, the CCC is planned to meet clinical, academic and research needs as a full, comprehensive cancer care facility. The focus of the new centre is on the development of an interdisciplinary and integrated care philosophy that accommodates research, education and patient and family centred care with improved patient outcomes.
- In order to best meet the long-term needs of the Calgary Cancer Service Plan, the CCC will be constructed at the Foothills Medical Centre (FMC) on the current location of Parking Lot 7. This will integrate cancer care with current key programs and services at the FMC.
- Construction of the CCC is planned to begin by the end of 2017 with the new facility opening to the public in 2023.

- The new Calgary Cancer Centre is part of a comprehensive infrastructure strategy for cancer treatment in Calgary that includes both inpatient and outpatient services. Services are based on clinical priorities as identified by the Alberta Health Services Calgary Cancer Service Plan 2012 that include:
 - Outpatient cancer clinics
 - o Inpatient unit beds
 - Operational and clinical support services
 - o Clinical trials unit and research laboratories
 - Systemic and radiation treatment services
 - New on-site parking
